Welcome to the new cycle map route for Bury St Edmunds. The last map to be produced was in 2010 and you will find that many improvements have been made to the cycle network since then, eg, the new Malthouse cycle and pedestrian bridge. Journeys by bike between home and many destinations within the town are now safer and more enjoyable.



However, a good cycling infrastructure is no use if no one knows about it and that is where this map comes in. We want to ensure that local people and tourists know what routes are available throughout the town and that it is possible to use this map in conjunction with the route numbers on the road signs.





Direction arrow End of cycle lane, track or route


**Advanced stop lines**


